Due to the increased cost of printing and postage, the annual Membership Dues will be increasing for 2022 Memberships.

Currently the costs are:

Individual: \$20.00

Family: \$35.00

Lifetime: \$200.00

2022 Memberships will increase as follow:

Individual \$25.00

Family: \$40.00

Lifetime: \$250.00

When we reviewed the last increase, we determined that it has been more than 15 years since the Membership rates have increased.
